RAMON GUTIERREZ

Intimate encounters through light and shadow


Ramon Gutierrez combines expression and action in his figures with a keen understanding of the dramatic nature of light in creating his widely collected impressionistic oil paintings.

“To counteract a dehumanized world, through my paintings I try to capture the importance of human emotions and relationships,” says Gutierrez. “My topics are always bound to the current moment I am living: maternity, childhood, expressions, gestures, the elderly and other striking moments of human existence.”

Academically trained in fine arts at the University of Barcelona, Gutierrez is most known for his thick oil strokes and heavy use of paint.

“My unique style is also influenced by the equally unique rhythms of jazz, rock, opera, blues and other musical genres which I listen to while I work,” says Gutierrez. “I was completely seduced by the works of Picasso and Van Gogh, even before using a paintbrush for the first time.”

Gutierrez uses these thick strokes of oil on multiple layers of canvas to achieve an almost three-dimensional effect in his work. He makes ample use of rich, vivid tones and textures by combining both drawing and painting. Gutierrez’s application of paint creates a beautiful balance between line and




WOMAN IN BLUE, OIL ON CANVAS, 40 X 30"

form, making his work seemingly come alive with intimate human sensations.

For this new exhibition in Southern California, Gutierrez will unveil about 12 new oil paintings, including figurative and still life works. The area of Spain where he resides, near the Costa Brava region, with its climate, proximity to the sea and lush vegetation, is almost identical to the area north of San Diego where this show will take place. ●
